

## Literacy, Languages and Communication:

- Setting Description – To write a setting based on the local woodland area.
- Story writing – Imaginative story writing based within a coastal or countryside setting – use 'Story Mountain' to plan the story.
- Question and Answer Leaflet – Based on wind power – explanations, positives, negatives, etc.

## Numeracy and Mathematics:

- Fractions – Recognising fractions, comparing and ordering fractions, adding and subtracting fractions.
